

PALAZZO VERSACE

Palazzo Versace is a prestigious waterfront five –star international hotel and condominiums project comprising 3 to 4 storeys, 205 rooms, 72 condominiums and a marina. The development is located on the Gold Coast with direct access to the Broadwater and Gold Coast Seaway.

Provision for the 90 – berth marina required dredging of an existing seabed lease including an existing sand bank to allow fishing trawlers unimpeded access adjacent to the marina through to the main north south navigation channel within the Southport Broadwater.
